

**THE SOULARD COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT**

**PROPOSAL TO IMPOSE A ONE PERCENT (1%) SALES AND USE TAX**

**OFFICIAL BALLOT**

Shall the Soulard Community Improvement District (the “District”) impose a community improvement district-wide sales and use tax on all retail sales within the District which are subject to taxation under the provisions of Sections 144.010 to 144.525 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended, with certain exceptions set forth in Section 67.1545 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended, at the maximum rate of one percent (1%) (the “CID Sales Tax”) for a period beginning the first day of the second calendar quarter after the Director of the Missouri Department of Revenue receives notice of the adoption of the sales and use tax, such beginning date expected to be January 1, 2020, and ending December 31, 2029. The purpose of the CID Sales Tax will be to finance the Project described in the petition establishing the District.
